Critical Area Buffer Management Plan

The policies of the Dorchester County Critical Area Protection Program and Maryland Critical Area Law provide that forested vegetation will be maintained and increased, forests and developed woodlands will be conserved, and tree removal associated with development activities will be mitigated. Impacts to the tidewater and expanded Buffers must be mitigated by the planting and maintenance of native vegetation according to COMAR 27.01.09.01-2. Depending on the amount and type of impact or establishment, this form may constitute a Simplified, Minor, or Major Buffer Management Plan.

This form is used for establishment of the Buffer, Buffer mitigation, and disturbances associated with providing access to a private pier or shoreline, manually removing invasive or noxious vegetation, filling to maintain an existing lawn, removing a tree which is likely to cause damage to structures, obstruct a stream, or accelerate shoreline erosion, or removing a diseased or dying tree.

Requirements:

- For all Buffer Management Plans (BMPs), a site or sketch plan must be attached which indicates the location and amount of disturbance and the location, amount, and type of mitigation plantings.
- In the case of a Minor or Major BMP,
 - o the size of trees removed must be documented,
 - o a landscape schedule which shows proposed species type, quantity and size of plants, and proposed planting date must be included,
 - a maintenance plan for the control of invasive species, pests, and predation with provisions for two years
 of monitoring and reinforcement plantings must be submitted, and
- In the case of a Major BMP, a surety representing 120% of the cost of plant material, installation labor, and maintenance of plantings must be provided concurrent with a planting plan agreement.
- All establishment/mitigation plantings must be native to Maryland.
- All contractors performing home improvement work in the Critical Area must be MHIC licensed.
