



Do you know Dorchester County's Permit Regulations?

- A building permit is required for all new residential or commercial construction in Dorchester County.
- While permit requirements will differ based on the scope of work, these are some examples of when a permit is required:
 - New construction or demolition of a building, addition, or structure, such as a porch, deck, gazebo, pier, pole building, garage, etc.
 - o Interior alterations, including alterations involving the removal or addition of any wall, partition or portion thereof, of any structural component
 - o Reroofing
 - The installation, repair or upgrade of electrical wiring, fire protection, plumbing, and mechanical systems.
 - o Sheds, pools, signs, solar panels

- Please be aware the above list does not include every type of permit required by Dorchester County.
- If you are doing any work type of work, it is always best to call us to see if you need a permit.
- Penalties apply for work done without the required permits.
