What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan ?	For participating providers \$1,300 person / \$2,600 family	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan , they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
