

**RESOLUTION NO. 454**

**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS**, the Dorchester County Council wish to establish a Traffic Safety Committee to assist with issues regarding County roads; and

**WHEREAS**, the Dorchester County Council wants to ensure that the residents of Dorchester County are being served in an effective and efficient manner with issues regarding County roads.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the County Council of Dorchester County, by this Resolution hereby declare:

- a. There is hereby created a Traffic Safety Committee.
- a. The Traffic Safety Committee shall consist of four members from the following: Sheriff, Public Works Director or assigned Division Heads as assigned by the County Manager or Public Safety Director or assigned Division Heads as assigned by the County Manager and one representative from the County Council.
- b. The role of the Traffic Safety Committee is to address issues that arise regarding County roads including but not limited to changing speed limit signs and placement of traffic signs.
- c. The Traffic Safety Committee will provide advice and recommendations to the County Council but will not be a decision/policy making group.
- d. The Traffic Safety Committee shall meet at least quarterly and will forward Minutes/proceedings of each meeting to the County Council for their information.
- e. The Board shall annually select a Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary from the membership and shall adopt rules of procedure in order to conduct meetings.
